

INSTALLATION, USE AND CARE



Ensure that your wall oven is installed by a qualified technician according to GE's installation guidelines. Proper installation is crucial for safety and optimal performance.

Preheating the Oven: Always preheat the oven to the recommended temperature before placing food inside. This ensures even cooking and accurate baking times.

Set the desired temperature and cooking mode using the control panel.

Self-Cleaning Function: If your wall oven has a self-cleaning feature, follow the manufacturer's instructions carefully. Remove any large food debris before starting the cycle, and ensure the area is well-ventilated during cleaning.





Avoid Overloading: Do not overload the oven with multiple dishes at once, as this can impede airflow and result in uneven cooking. Space out dishes to allow heat to circulate freely.

Using the Right Cookware: Use oven-safe cookware that can withstand high temperatures. Avoid using glass or ceramic dishes unless they are specifically labeled as oven-safe.

Keep flammable items away from the oven while it is in use.

Avoid storing items in the oven, especially when it's not in use.

Use oven mitts or pot holders when handling hot cookware to prevent burns. Do not use commercial oven cleaners or protective coatings in a self-cleaning oven.
